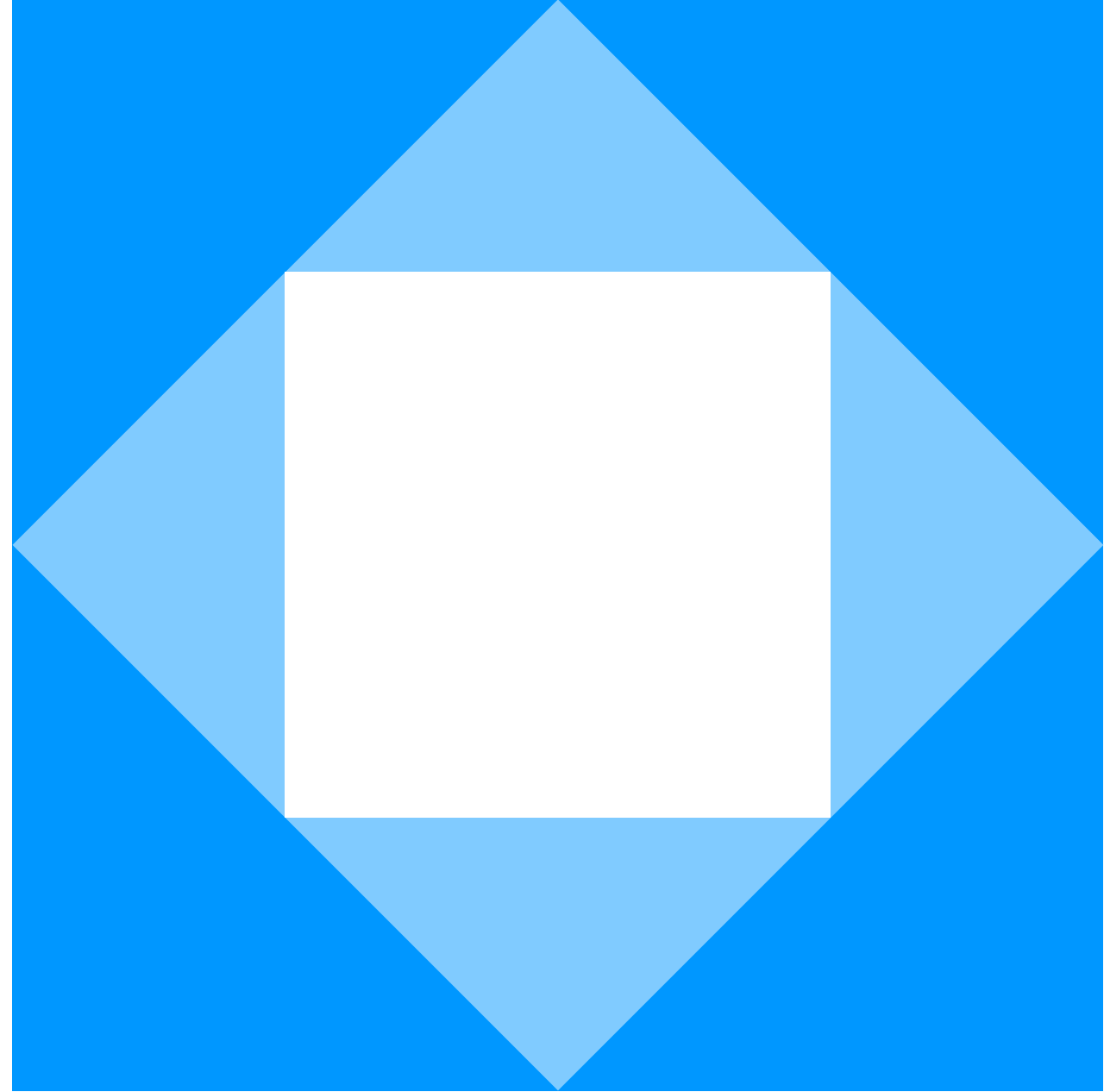

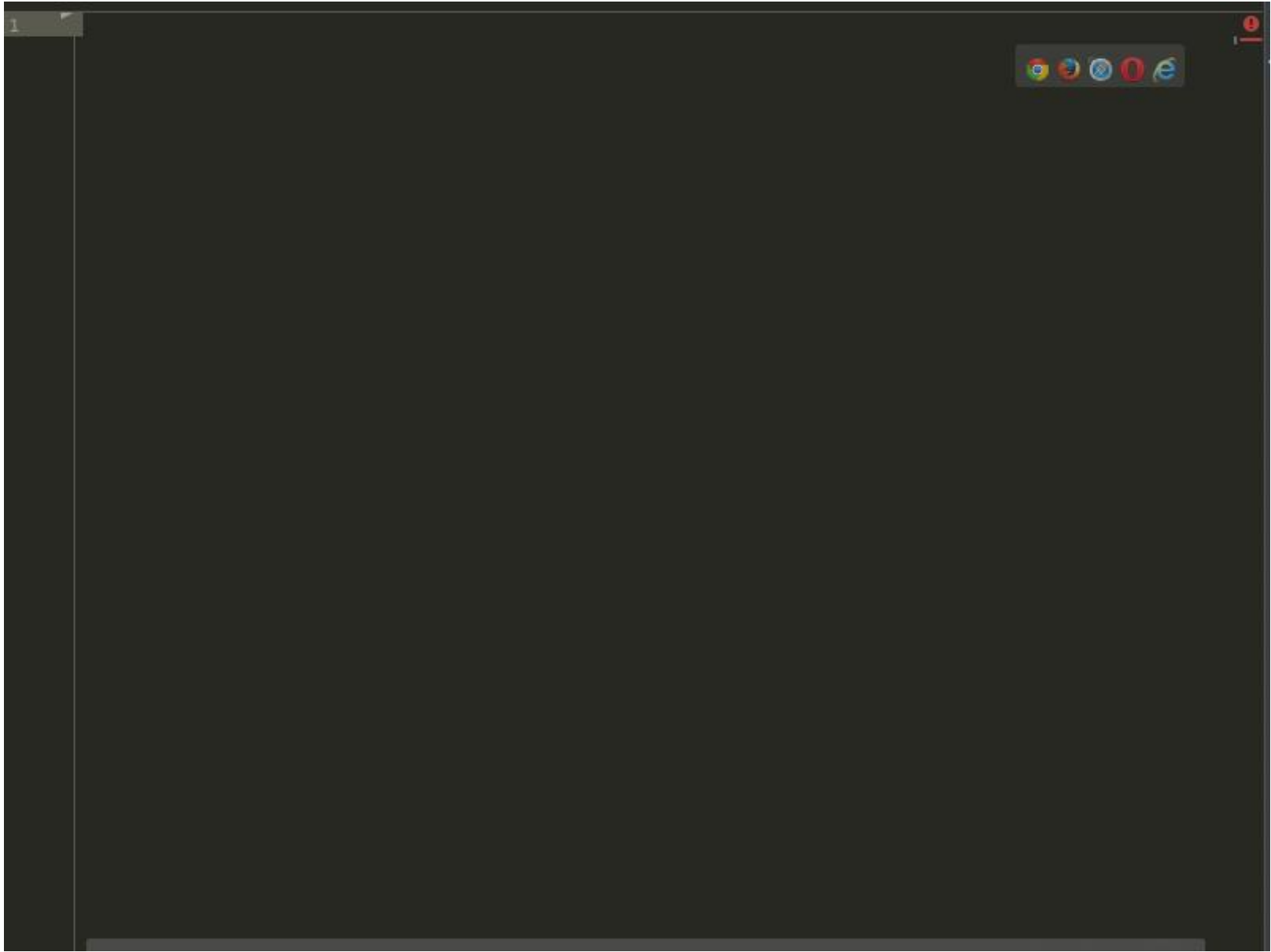
Pros:

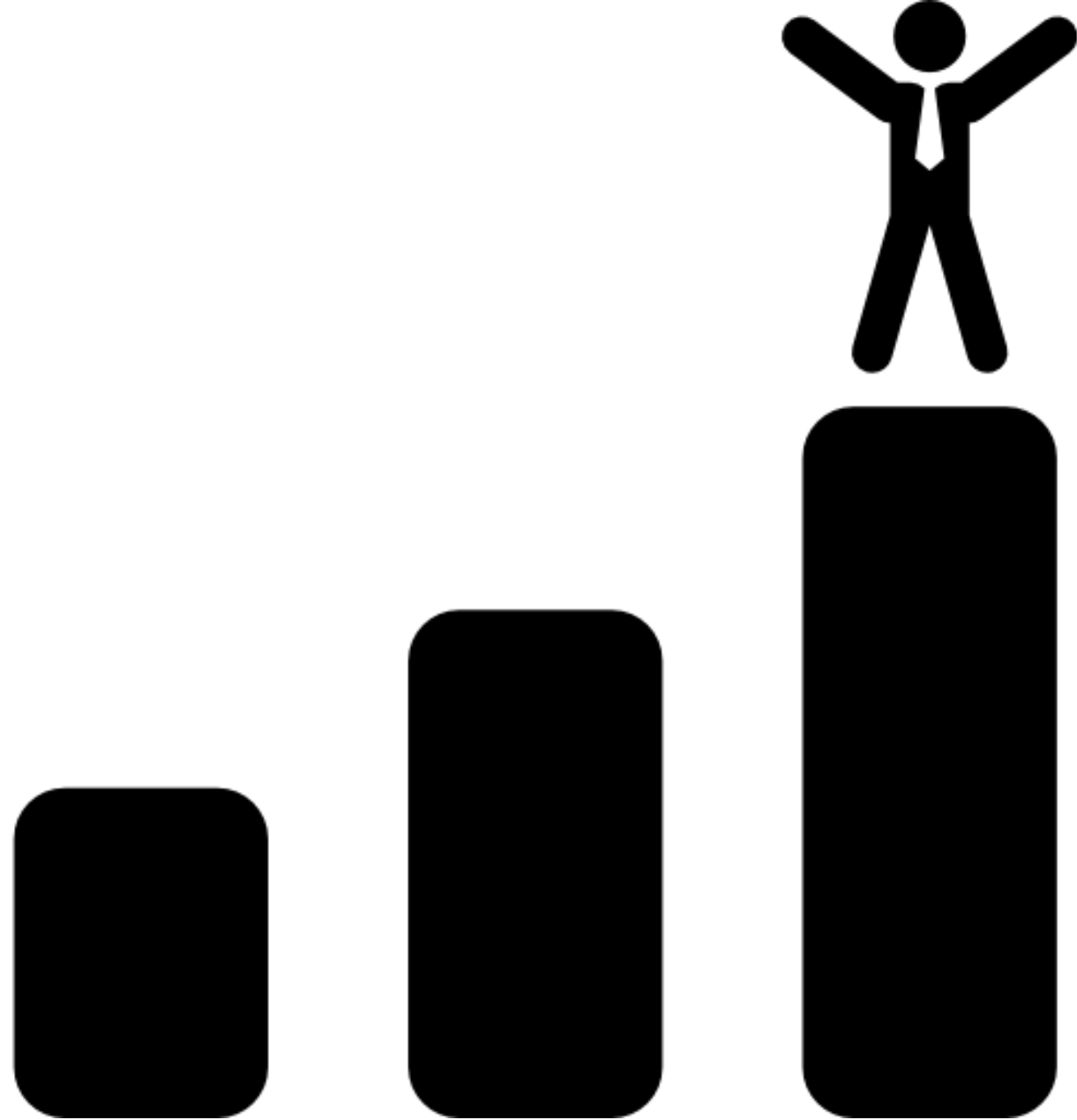

- Touch UI dialog support (_cq_dialog.xml)

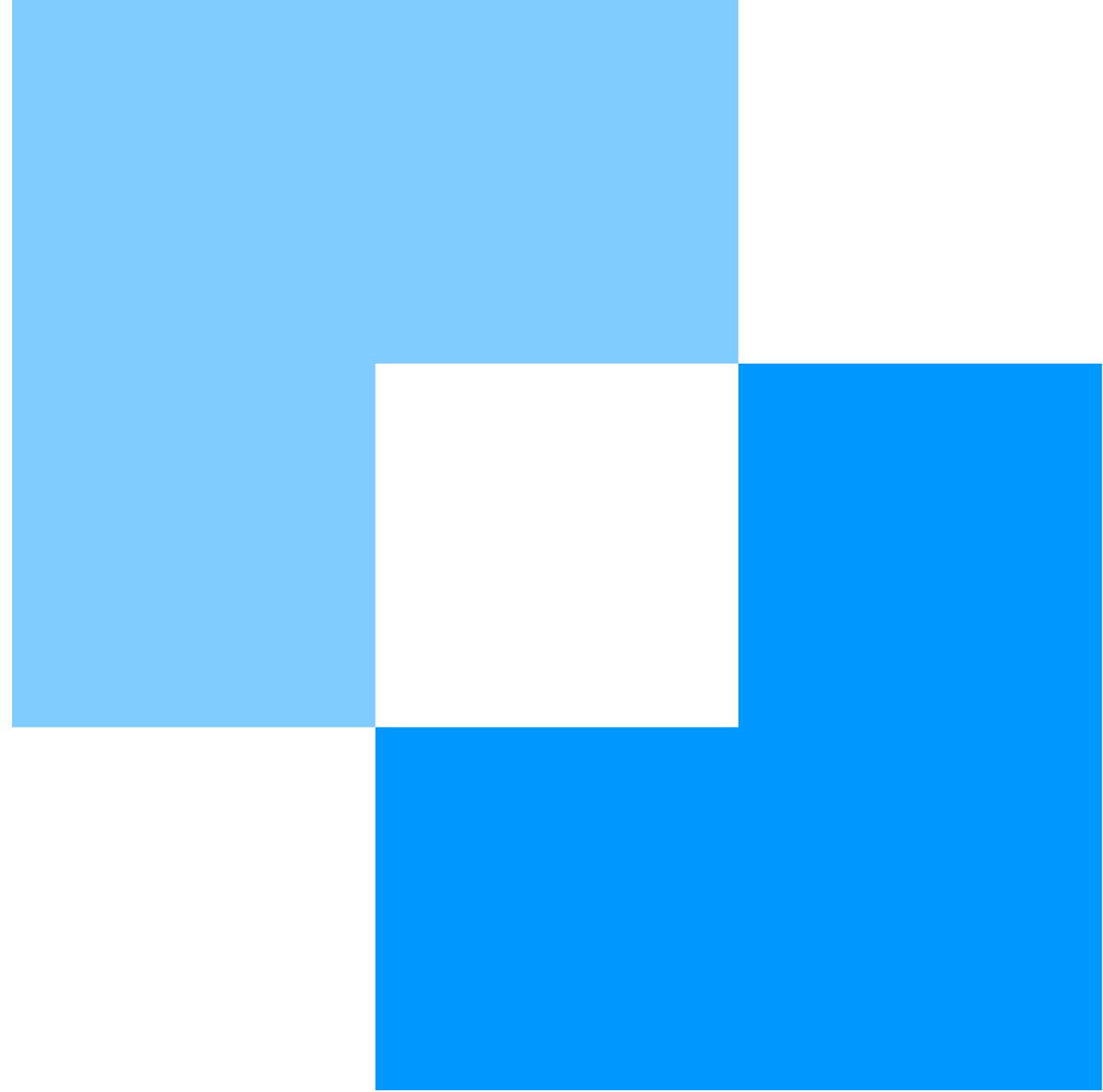

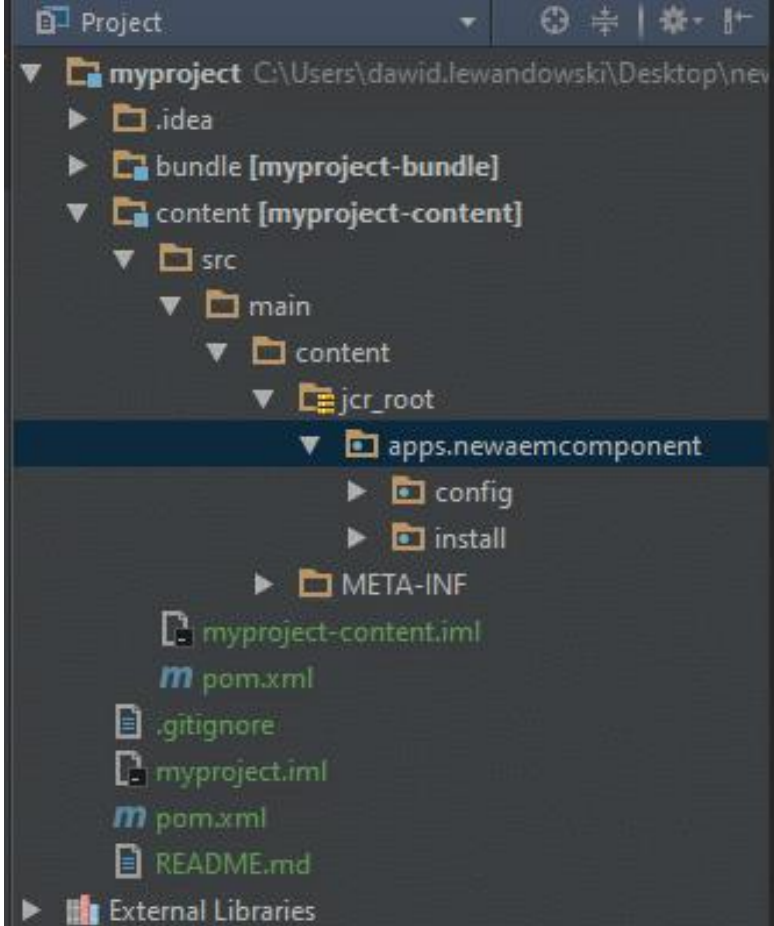
